# Collaborative's Responsibility

---

- Serve as a hub for information on statewide energy and climate action in New Hampshire;
- Connect implementing partners: institutions, groups/individuals, and networks from various sectors that are active in the New Hampshire energy and climate arena;
- When necessary, provide a forum for problem solving (barriers) on key energy and climate issues in the state that are not being addressed by existing institutions, groups/individuals, and networks;
- Track progress of statewide actions against the 67 recommendations in the Climate Action Plan
- Share success stories through a variety of communication avenues.

# Implementing Partners

---

## – Networks

- Group of institutions and individuals/actions that are working together on common goals and recommended actions from the Climate Action Plan for a given sector or sectors. Example: EESE Board

## – Institutions

- Individual statewide or large regional agencies and organizations that are working independently and/or collaborating within networks with other institutions within a given sector. Example: NHDOT

## – Groups/Individuals

- Entity responsible for the coordination of a project or program at a local level. Example: The Atkinson Energy Committee
