	Questions	Answers
1.	Can a contractor be deemed eligible for this RFP if they are currently providing program design, delivery and/or evaluation support to one or more of New Hampshire's electric or gas utilities, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission or other New Hampshire State Agency?	No, such a contractor would not be eligible for this RFP.
2.	Would the contractor selected to provide services under this RFP be precluded from submitting proposals, and providing subsequent program design, delivery and/or evaluation support to New Hampshire's electric or gas utilities, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission or other New Hampshire State Agency in response to RFPs that might be issued (or sole-sourced work that might be requested/assigned) during or following the end of this project's envisioned contract term?	Yes, the selected Contractor would be so precluded during the contract term but not after the term had been completed. However, the selected Contractor would not be precluded from bidding on RFPs issued by the PUC for continued EERS Planning Services, even if such RFPs were issued during the contract term of this RFP.
