1.	<p>a. If a project is about to begin construction is it still eligible?</p> <p>b. When will a determination be made on who will receive the funding?</p>	<p>a. A project that is about to begin construction may still be considered eligible for grant funding. However, as stated on page 3 of the RFP, item #9 of "Basic Project Eligibility Requirements," please be aware that "Costs incurred prior to final grant agreement approval by the G&C are not eligible for reimbursement."</p> <p>b. Project proposals are due by October 31st. Review and scoring will occur during the 4-8 weeks after that date. Final funding decisions are expected to be made by the Public Utilities Commission by the end of this calendar year. Grant awardees would be notified at that point, as contract terms, conditions, and details need to be developed and finalized. Finally, the executed grant contracts must be submitted to the Governor and Executive Council for approval. Historically, grant contracts have received final approval in March of the year following the RFP issuance.</p>
