PROCEEDINGS 1 2 CHAIRMAN GETZ: Okay. Good morning. 3 We'll open the prehearing conference in docket DE 07-070. On June 4, 2007, Public Service Company of New Hampshire 4 5 filed a petition to issue up to \$200 million principal б amount of long-term debt securities through December 31, 7 2008, to mortgage property, to utilize interest rate 8 locks, and to permanently increase its short-term debt limit to 10 percent of net fixed plant, plus a fixed 9 amount of \$35 million. According to PSNH, total capital 10 11 expenditures are projected to approach \$211 million in 2007 and \$219 million in 2008. 12 13 Commission issued an order of notice on 14 June 15 setting the prehearing conference for this morning. Note for the record that the affidavit of 15 publication has been filed. And, so, I think we can turn 16 to appearances please. 17 18 MS. SHIVELY: Good morning, Mr. 19 Chairman, Commissioners. So, we haven't 20 21 taken a position at this point, and hope that, after this 22 next round of discovery, we'll be able to make a recommendation to the Commission. 23 CHAIRMAN GETZ: And, so, the expectation 24

1 is that, coming out of the technical session, there will 2 be a proposal on a procedural schedule, is that correct? MS. AMIDON: Because PSNH requested that 3 4 an order be issued no later than August 1, we have already 5 requested and I believe that order of notice scheduled a 6 hearing for July 24th, I believe. So, I'm assuming that 7 we'll go forward and have that hearing, whether or not we 8 reach agreement or whether we have, you know, a contested 9 proceeding. 10 CHAIRMAN GETZ: Okay. Is there anything 11 further for us to address this morning? (No verbal response) 12 CHAIRMAN GETZ: Okay. Then, hearing 13 14 nothing, we will close the prehearing conference and expect to go to hearing on July 24th.
