Dear Ms. Howland:

At the conclusion of the first round of discovery in the above-captioned proceeding, Staff and the parties discussed certain changes to the procedural schedule. Based on those discussions, Staff and the parties agreed to recommend to the Commission that the existing schedule be modified by revising the dates for the Set 2 data requests to be issued to the Company, the responses to those data requests and the subsequent technical session as follows:

Data Requests to Company—Set 2	June 13, 2008 (no change)
Additional Set 2 Data Requests to Company (to be numbered consecutively with those issued June 13)	June 20, 2008
Company Responses to Set 2 data requests	July 11, 2008
Temporary Rate Settlement	July 22, 2008
Technical session	July 24, 25, 2008 (9:00 a.m.)

The Staff and parties also wish to inform the Commission that they have reached agreement in principle on temporary rates and expect to file testimony regarding that settlement as soon as possible.
