
Renewal Registration as a Competitive Natural Gas Supplier

Dear Mr. Pozza:

On February 29, 2008, Metromedia Energy, Inc. filed with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) an application for renewal of registration as a competitive natural gas supplier (CNGS), together with a check in the amount of \$250.00. On May 14, 2007, Metromedia Energy, Inc. filed with the Commission a Bond Continuance Certificate for a renewal of Metromedia Energy's \$50,000 Surety Bond with a term which will remain in full force through April 21, 2008 (re. DM 06-034).

The Commission has reviewed Metromedia Energy, Inc.'s application for renewal registration as a CNGS. Its application meets the requirements for registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.01. Therefore, the Commission will approve Metromedia Energy, Inc. as a CNGS in the State of New Hampshire, with the renewal registration to be effective April 7, 2008, which coincides with the expiration of the current registration. This renewed registration will expire on April 7, 2010 or on the earlier termination or expiration and non-renewal of the Surety Bond.

Included with the February 28, 2008 renewal registration, Metromedia Energy, Inc. filed with the Commission a Motion for the Confidential Treatment of Financial Information that was included as Exhibit E of the CNGS renewal application. Also on February 28, 2008, Metromedia Energy, Inc. filed with the Commission a copy of a Demand Discretionary Credit Agreement, as amended, with Metromedia Company, marked confidential. The Commission construes the Motion for Confidential Treatment as including a request for confidential treatment of this Agreement. The Commission will take no action on the Motion for Confidential Treatment at this time but will



nonetheless treat the financial statements and Demand Discretionary Credit Agreement, as confidential documents and not to be made available to the public unless and until the Commission rules on the Motion for Confidential Treatment in the future.
