Renewal Registration as a Natural Gas Aggregator

Dear Mr. Cournoyer:

On March 26, 2008, UMG, Inc. filed with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) an application for renewal of registration as a natural gas aggregator. The application meets the requirements for renewal registration as required by the Commission pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02. Therefore, the Commission will approve UMG, Inc. as a natural gas aggregator in the State of New Hampshire, with the registration to be effective May 15, 2008. This registration will expire on May 15, 2010.

Additionally, please bear in mind that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02 (e), each aggregator applicant shall re-register with the Commission every 2 years by filing an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its registration. UMG, Inc.'s renewal application will be due on or before March 15, 2010.
