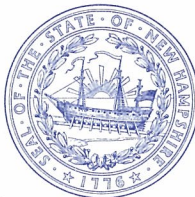

Dear Ms. Howland:

Yesterday the Commission held a hearing on a stipulation and settlement agreement between Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH) and Commission Staff in the above-captioned docket. Because the stipulation and settlement agreement was largely based on the testimony of Michael D. Cannata, Jr., Staff's consultant who reviewed the operation and outages at PSNH's generation units, Staff intended, but neglected, to file Mr. Cannata's testimony as an exhibit. Mr. Cannata's testimony was filed in this docket on October 24, 2008.

The purpose of this letter is to request that the Commission re-open the hearing record in Docket No. DE 08-066 for the sole purpose of entering Mr. Cannata's testimony as Exhibit 6. Mr. Cannata's testimony is a critical component in this docket and is necessary to complete the record.

PSNH has informed Staff that it supports this request. The Office of Consumer Advocate does not object.
