Yesterday the Commission held a hearing on a stipulation and settlement agreement between Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH) and Commission Staff in the above-captioned docket. Because the stipulation and settlement agreement was largely based on the testimony of Michael D. Cannata, Jr., Staff's consultant who reviewed the operation and outages at PSNH's generation units, Staff intended, but neglected, to file Mr. Cannata's testimony as an exhibit.
