Good morning. 3 We'll open the prehearing conference in docket DE 08-066. 4 On May 1, 2008, Public Service Company of New Hampshire 5 filed testimony and schedules in support of its proposed б reconciliation of revenues and costs associated with its 7 Energy Service Charge and Stranded Cost Recovery Charge 8 for calendar year 2007. An order of notice was issued on June 4 setting the prehearing conference for this morning. 9 10 I'll note for the record that the affidavit of publication has been filed, and that the Consumer Advocate has filed 11 notice that it will be participating in this proceeding. 12 13 Can we take appearances please. 14 MR. EATON: For Public Service Company of New Hampshire, my name is Gerald M. Eaton. 15 CMSR. BELOW: Good morning. 16 CMSR. MORRISON: Good morning. 17 CHAIRMAN GETZ: Good morning. 18 19 MS. HATFIELD: Good morning, Commissioners. And, with me today is Steve 3 4 Mullen, who is the Assistant Director of the Electric 5 Division. б CMSR. BELOW: Good morning. 7 CMSR. MORRISON: Good morning. CHAIRMAN GETZ: Good morning. Anything 8 we need to address before we allow the opportunity for the 9 parties to state their preliminary positions? 10 11 (No verbal response) 12 CHAIRMAN GETZ: Hearing nothing, Mr. 13 Eaton. 14 MR. EATON: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. Public Service Company of New Hampshire has submitted its 15 information for the calendar year 2007 for the Energy 16 Service Rate and also Stranded Cost Recovery Charge. We 17 believe that the costs that were submitted are reasonable 18 19 and were incurred prudently. We submitted the testimony 20 of Mr. Baumann, which summarized the data; Mr. Labrecque, 21 who explained PSNH's purchases for supplemental power 22 during the period; and Mr. Smagula, who described the 23 major outages that took place at our generating stations. 24 We look forward to answering data {DG 08-066} [Prehearing conference] (06-26-08)

requests from the parties and work out, through technical 1 2 sessions, narrow the issues, and perhaps even come upon a 3 settlement that we could submit to the Commission. There 4 has been a procedural schedule that was circulated by 5 Staff, and we're looking at that right now. Thank you. 6 CHAIRMAN GETZ: Thank you. Ms. 7 Hatfield. 8 MS. HATFIELD: Thank you. The OCA does not have a position at this time, but we look forward to 9 working with the Company and with Staff to review the 10 issues in the case. Thank you. 11 CHAIRMAN GETZ: Thank you. Ms. Amidon. 12 13 MS. AMIDON: As is customary in these 14 dockets, we will be looking -- we'll be conducting discovery and we'll be examining the outages at the plants 15 and the various other components of this filing. And, we 16 intend to have a technical session following this hearing 17 to establish a procedural schedule. And, we'll be filing 18 19 that with the Commission shortly. 20 CHAIRMAN GETZ: Okay. Then, we will 21 close this prehearing conference, await a recommendation 22 on a procedural schedule, and take the matter under 23 advisement. Thank you.
