Dear Ms. Howland:

I am writing to follow up on your letter dated August 29, 2008 regarding the Commission's ruling on the pending discovery and procedural disputes in this case. The data requests that are the subject of Constellation's pending Motion to Compel are not dependent on whether Lempster Wind, LLC is a party to this proceeding and therefore they are not affected by the rulings set forth in your August 29 letter. Nevertheless, Constellation has decided to withdraw Set 1 Data Requests 2, 8, 11 and 25 and Set 2 Data Requests 1, 11 and 13 from the scope of its motion. The data requests that remain to be ruled on are:

> Set 1—1, 5, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 23, 24 and 29 Set 2—7 and 8

In addition, Constellation is willing to narrow Data Requests 1-14, 2-7 and 2-8 so they are limited to Class I renewable energy certificates ("RECs"). Further, with regard to Constellation 1-14 and 2-8, Constellation would be satisfied with confirmation by PSNH that the answer previously provided is complete as to the time periods referred to in the questions or a complete answer as to Class I RECs if it is not.

For ease of reference, I am enclosing a copy of PSNH's responses to the foregoing data requests for where PSNH responded in some form. (PSNH did not respond at all to Constellation 1-1, 5, 13, 15, 24 or 29, other than its initial objection.) In addition, I am enclosing excerpts from PSNH's responses to Constellation's Set 3 Data Requests, to the extent that those

responses relate to the Set 1 and Set 2 Data Requests that are the subject of the Motion to Compel.

I have consulted with counsel for PSNH to inform them of this revised list of data requests prior to submitting it to the Commission.
