1	I.	Background
2	Q.	Mr. Bessette, please state your name, business address and position with
3		Constellation.
4	A.	My name is Thomas E. Bessette and my business address is Constellation
5		NewEnergy, Inc., 800 Boylston Street, 28 th Floor, Boston, MA 02199. I am Vice
6		President for Energy Policy for the New England market of Constellation
7		NewEnergy, a subsidiary of Constellation Energy Group, Inc.

9	Q.	Mr. McLeish, please state your name, business address and position with
10		Constellation.
11	A.	My name is Bruce McLeish and my business address is Constellation
12		NewEnergy, Inc., 8 Morrison Street, Providence, RI 02906. I am Senior Vice
13		President of Products and Pricing for Constellation NewEnergy.

15	Q.	Mr. Bessette, please describe your educational and professional background.
16	A.	I have a Bachelor of Arts degree in political science from Boston College and a
17		law degree from Boston College Law School. I also have a Masters in
18		Management degree from Lesley College. Most recently, I was in-house counsel
19		and the manager of regulatory and commercial affairs of TransÉnergie U.S. Ltd.,
20		an independent electric transmission company that develops merchant
21		transmission projects. I have also served as government affairs director for
22		PG&E National Energy Group, Inc., and have held prior positions at the

Massachusetts Department of Public Utilities ("DPU"), where I was the director of the electric power division and acting general counsel. While at the Massachusetts DPU, I first served as Senior Attorney and later as Assistant General Counsel. Among my other responsibilities at the DPU, I directed the regulatory, policy and legislative initiatives to restructure the electric industry in Massachusetts to allow for customer choice of generation supply. I also acted as hearing officer for the DPU's two historic electric restructuring cases, D.P.U. 95-30 and D.P.U. 96-100, which provided for customer choice in the provision of generation supply. Earlier in my career I served as senior attorney at COM/Energy Services Company in Cambridge, Massachusetts. I have participated in a number of professional associations including The Electric Power Supply Association and The Northeast Energy and Commerce Association. Additionally, I have spoken extensively on a range of energy issues, including the importance of fuel diversity in New England to electric industry restructuring.

Q. Mr. McLeish, please describe your educational and professional background.

I have a Bachelor of Science degree from Syracuse University and a Masters degree from Emerson College. I have over twenty years experience in the electric industry with an emphasis on wholesale origination efforts. In my current capacity, I oversee the development of energy management products for businesses in both regulated and deregulated states, as well as management of all capabilities needed to support product sales and delivery. Additionally, I was instrumental in enabling the development of several new wind and land-fill gas

1		power plants by entering into long-term contracts to purchase their output. Earlier
2		in my career, I was responsible for revenue generation through the sale and
3		purchase of wholesale power contracts and I also traded options and electricity in
4		the hourly, daily, weekly, and monthly markets with wholesale entities throughout
5		New England, New York, and Canada.
6		I have been featured in numerous pieces discussing the key trends and
7		opportunities in competitive markets and their impact on businesses, including
8		articles published by the Associated Press, and in regional weeklies such as Mass
9		High Tech and The Boston Business Journal along with industry publications
10		including Renewable Energy Report, Power Markets Week, Energy Washington
11		Week, and Automated Buildings.com. I have also been a featured speaker at a
12		number of conferences and industry events including the Emissions Markets
13		Association, the 100 th Restructuring Roundtable, The Renewable Energy
14		Leadership Summit sponsored by the Center for Ecological Technology, and as
15		the Keynote Speaker at the Northeast Energy and Commerce Association's
16		Renewable Power Conference.
