Dear Customers of Hampstead Area Water Co., Inc.:

On June 17, 2008 Hampstead Area Water Co., Inc. (HAWC) filed a petition with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (PUC) for authority to borrow long term debt including a step increase in rates.

HAWC intends to borrow \$1,100,885 from the State Revolving Loan Fund (SRF) administered by the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services (DES) at an interest rate of 3.488%. The proceeds of the loan will be used to finance the construction of an interconnection between HAWC's two core systems in the Towns of Hampstead and Atkinson.

This extension is part of a long range plan which includes water source stability, drought protection, water conservation and fire suppression for the protection and benefit of our customer base. The Company has consulted with both the PUC and DES as part of its emergency plan.

HAWC estimates, based on projected costs for the project, that rates would increase 6.73%. The Company anticipates applying a N. H. Water System Interconnection Grant to the projected costs which will reduce the estimated rate increase by approximately 1.25%, resulting in a rate increase of approximately 5.5%.
