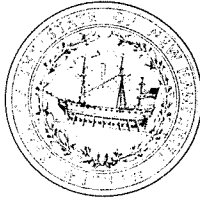

On September 22, 2009, you filed on behalf of the Warner Village Water District a request to discontinue service to the four non-district customers on North Village Road in Warner which is the subject of the above referenced matter. You also requested, to the extent necessary, a modification of the franchise boundaries.

In order to issue a decision on your request, the Commission requires the following information:

- 1) Evidence of the compliance of the four wells with the provisions of RSA 485-A:29 and RSA 485-A:30-b;
- 2) A description or map (preferably both) detailing the requested revision of the boundaries of the precinct's water franchise area.
