In responding to Staff Data Request 1-1, Aquarion Water Company of New Hampshire determined that certain schedules filed with its initial filing in this docket contained incorrect historical information for the twelve months ending March 31, 2006 and 2007. None of this information affects the test year data supplied with the filing, but in order to ensure that Aquarion's filing with the Commission is corrected, I am enclosing the following revised pages:

Statement of Utility Operating Income, Schedule 1 (REVISED)
pages 1 and 2—permanent rate filing


Sections 1, 18 and 19 to PUC filing requirements (Puc 1604.01)

The enclosed pages are intended to replace the existing pages in Aquarion's original filing with the Commission in this docket. The only change in Schedule 1 to the temporary and permanent rate filing information is the information in the columns showing historical data for the years ending March 31, 2006 and 2007. Similarly, the information previously filed in Sections 1, 18 and 19 of the PUC filing requirements contained erroneous historical data. Rather than replace individual pages to these sections, Aquarion is providing a complete set of new pages for the entirety of each of the three sections.
