Dear Ms. Howland:

Following the prehearing conference on February 6, 2009, Staff, the OCA, Comcast Phone of NH, LLC (Comcast), Kearsarge Telephone Company, Merrimack County Telephone Company and Wilton Telephone Company (TDS) attended a technical session at which they agreed upon a partial proposed procedural schedule for this docket. The schedule is partial because participants agreed that future scheduling will depend upon the outcome of follow-up data requests to be submitted by the TDS.

Participants agreed to the following proposed procedural schedule:

Participants anticipate that once the Commission receives the forthcoming filings, the Commission will then decide whether it requires further briefing and/or whether an evidentiary hearing will be held. At that time, another technical session may be necessary to establish a proposed briefing schedule and/or hearing date.

Because this docket was initiated as a request for arbitration pursuant to provisions of federal law, participants agreed that the nine-month deadline to decide the matter (April 5, 2009) could be a complicating factor and should be extended until at least May 15, 2009. Participants therefore agreed to extend the deadline to at least May 15, 2009, without prejudice or waiver of any rights regarding the question of whether Comcast is not a telecommunications carrier entitled to interconnect.
