On December 31, 2008 Public Power & Utility, Inc. filed an application to become registered as a competitive electric power supplier. On January 13, 2009 Staff issued a deficiency letter enumerating nine items which needed to be addressed.

On July 24, an email was sent to Mr. David Pearsall, President, in which it was noted that the docket might be closed without prejudice if the company was not going to respond to the January 13 letter. Since then, most recently on October 5, Staff informed the company, through its representative Mr. Besnik Islami, that the application needed to be completed. Mr. Islami stated that he was waiting for the financial security required by Puc 2003.01 (d) (4) but that he would send in the rest of the application. As of this date, Staff has received no further information from the company.

It is Staff's recommendation that this docket be closed without prejudice. Should Public Power & Utility, Inc. wish to become registered in the future, it should start the application process anew in its entirety.
