Re: Enel Green Power North America, Inc.'s Request to Reinstate First Quarter 2010 New Hampshire Class IV RECs

Dear Mr. Barreveld:

On June 14, 2011, you submitted a letter to the Commission on behalf of CHI Power Marketing, Inc. (CHI), requesting that the Commission inform the New England Power Pool Generation Information System (GIS) Administrator that 1,067 expired renewable energy certificates (RECs) from the first quarter of 2010 are eligible to be recognized and submitted for 2010 New Hampshire Class IV Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) compliance so that they can be reinstated in the GIS and made available for immediate transfer.

According to your letter, CHI did not trade or bank the aforementioned RECs within the relevant trading period, July 15, 2010 to September 15, 2010, and, as a result, the RECs were deleted from the GIS. These RECs are associated with output from the Salmon Falls hydroelectric power facility during the first quarter of 2010 and would have been eligible for New Hampshire 2010 Class IV RPS compliance.

The GIS Administrator has informed the Commission that it is able to reinstate the RECs, pursuant to GIS Operating Rule 3.8(d), which addresses REC banking neglect. Furthermore, the Commission received your signed attestation stating that the RECs in question will not be used for any purpose other than New Hampshire Class IV RPS compliance.

The Commission has reviewed your letter, supporting documentation and the GIS Operating Rules and determined that the above referenced RECs from the first quarter of 2010 are eligible for New Hampshire Class IV RPS compliance.
