I am very concerned at the new rate change plan proposed by PSNH. I understand the need to make a privately-owned utility profitable, which in itself speaks to the wisdom of that structure, but I am concerned that the new plan runs counter to the nationwide effort to curb our energy usage as a whole, and our fossil fuel usage particularly.
