On August 26, 2009, you filed on behalf of EnergyNorth Natural Gas, Inc. d/b/a/ National Grid NH (National Grid) a request to extend the time from August 31, 2009 to September 30, 2009 to file updated program descriptions, cost benefit analyses, program budgets and program goals for Program Year Two. You note in your letter that the Company seeks additional time so that it may file its gas and electric updates simultaneously on September 30. Additionally, you note that granting the requested extension will give National Grid the time necessary to collaborate with the other settling parties, as required by the settlement agreement approved by Commission Order No. 24,995 (July 31, 2009).
