On April 13, 2009 FairPoint Communications, Inc. filed with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission a special contract for service with RBS Citizens. The contract was approved by the NHPUC and made effective on April 29, 2009 for a 24 months term with an expiration date of April 29, 2011.
