Dear Director Howland:

On behalf of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. ("Unitil"), please accept this letter requesting a temporary suspension of the date to comply with paragraph 2.9 of the Settlement Agreement on Time-of-Use Pilot Program ("Settlement") in the above-referenced docket. The Settlement was approved by the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") on February 26, 2010 in Order No. 25,079.

Paragraph 2.9 provides that UES will develop a proposal for a TOU Pilot Program for its non-G1, non-Residential customers to be implemented during the summer of 2011, and that it will file such a proposal on or before November 1, 2010. As a result of the press of business and related matters, UES needs additional time to develop its proposal. The Company intends to meet with Commission Staff and any other interested party to determine a revised date for the filing of the non-G1TOU Pilot proposal, as soon as possible. Unitil will promptly advise the Commission of the results of this meeting and submit a recommendation for a revised filing date.
