This is to confirm that the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has received The Legacy Energy Group, LLC's (Legacy) notice of intent to provide electric aggregation service in the State of New Hampshire, pursuant to New Hampshire Administrative Rules Puc 2003.02. Staff has reviewed the application provided and believes that it meets the requirements of Puc 2003.02. Based on Staff's recommendation and the Commission's review, the Commission approves Legacy's application to provide electric aggregation service in New Hampshire.

Please note the following provision of Puc 2003.02 (f): "[E]ach aggregator shall re-file with the commission an up-to-date written notice of intent to provide service as an aggregator every 2 years on or before its original notice anniversary date. Legacy's original notice anniversary date is November 30, 2009 and therefore it is required to refile an up-to-date written notice on or before November 30, 2011 if it continues to offer and provide electric aggregation service. In addition, Legacy is subject to the provisions of Puc 2004.03, telephone solicitation of customers, and Puc 2004.07, customer protections provided by aggregators.
