Dear Ms. Howland:

Enclosed for filing with the Commission, in accordance with RSA Ch. 366:3, are seven (7) copies of a Utility Money Pool Agreement by and among KeySpan Corporation, National Grid Corporate Services LLC, The Brooklyn Union Gas Company, KeySpan Gas East Corporation, Boston Gas Company, Colonial Gas Company, Essex Gas Company, and EnergyNorth Natural Gas, Inc. ("EnergyNorth") dated as of January 1, 2010, (the "Legacy KeySpan Money Pool Agreement") The enclosed agreement renews the agreement that is currently in place and is a complete copy of the original agreement that is on file in the records of the company. A copy of this letter and the enclosed agreement is also being sent directly to Mark A. Naylor, Water and Gas Director.

On November 4, 2009, EnergyNorth and Granite State Electric Company ("Granite") filed with the Commission a form of regulated money pool agreement. Granite and EnergyNorth will become parties to this regulated money pool agreement when it is executed and made effective; the Legacy KeySpan Money Pool Agreement will be terminated at that time. However, it is not anticipated that the form of regulated money pool agreement filed on November 4, 2009 will be in effect prior to the expiration of the current Legacy KeySpan Money Pool Agreement on December 31, 2009. Therefore, the Legacy KeySpan Utility Money Pool Agreement was renewed.
