JOINT MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE FOR FILING BRIEFS

NOW COME the Petitioners and Lamplighter Mobile Home Park, LP (“LMHP”), Parties in the above-captioned matter, and pursuant to N.H. Admin. Rules Puc 202.04 and 203.07, respectfully request that this honorable Commission grant a two month extension for the Parties to file briefs in the above-captioned matter.¹ In support of this motion, the Parties state as follows:

1. The procedural schedule adopted by the Commission and noted in a letter from the Commission’s Executive Director dated July 15, 2010 requires any amendments to the Motion to Dismiss and Objection and supplemental briefs to be submitted on or before September 27, 2010.

2. The Parties are involved in negotiations and believe that an additional two months will provide a useful opportunity for them to attempt to resolve the underlying issues that have gave rise to the Petition in this matter.

3. Granting an extension of the deadline for filing briefs will not unduly delay the proceeding to the detriment of either party and will not adversely affect the rights of either party.

4. Staff concurs with the request for an extension.


¹ LMHP joins in this Motion subject to, and without waiving, its objection to the jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Commission in this matter.
