DUAL FUEL EQUIPMENT RIDER

1.0 PURPOSE

The purpose of this Rider is to enable a customer with dual fuel equipment under an applicable firm rate schedule to maintain access to capacity on the Company's distribution system, while displacing natural gas delivery service provided by the Company with the Customer's alternate fuel at the Customer's discretion. The terms of this Rider enable the Company to recover a minimum annual revenue requirement from such Customer during the period of reduced utilization of the Company's firm service, thereby protecting the Company's other customers against the shifting of such costs that might otherwise occur.

2.0 APPLICABILITY

This Rider shall be applicable to any Customer that is (1) taking firm delivery service under any of the Company's Commercial & Industrial Rate Schedules, (2) that has installed equipment capable of burning natural gas and one or more fuels not delivered by the Company for the same purpose, and (3) that meets the Company's criteria relative to Customer size, impact of Customer demand, and location of Customer on the Company's system as set forth in the Company's Policy on Dual Fuel Utilization.

3.0 NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENT

Customer is responsible for notifying the Company of any dual fuel equipment at Customer's location upon initial application for service under an applicable rate schedule. Any Customer that installs or has previously installed dual fuel equipment at any time while taking service from the Company under an applicable rate schedule shall notify the Company of the installation.

4.0 TERM

The minimum term shall be one year from the initial operation of dual fuel equipment by the Customer. The initial term shall be automatically extended for successive one year terms, unless terminated by written notice to the Company at least 30 days prior to the termination of the currently effective term. Should Customer cease taking service from the Company prior to the end of the term of this Rider, the terms of this Rider shall continue in effect until terminated in accordance with the terms herein.

1.0 PURPOSE

The purpose of this Rider is to enable a customer with dual fuel equipment under an applicable firm rate schedule to maintain access to capacity on the Company's distribution system, while displacing natural gas delivery service provided by the Company with the Customer's alternate fuel at the Customer's discretion. The terms of this Rider enable the Company to recover a minimum annual revenue requirement from such Customer during the period of reduced utilization of the Company's firm service, thereby protecting the Company's other customers against the shifting of such costs that might otherwise occur.

2.0 APPLICABILITY

This Rider shall be applicable to any Customer that is (1) taking firm delivery service under any of the Company's Commercial & Industrial Rate Schedules, (2) that has installed equipment capable of burning natural gas and one or more fuels not delivered by the Company for the same purpose, and (3) that meets the Company's criteria relative to Customer size, impact of Customer demand, and location of Customer on the Company's system as set forth in the Company's Policy on Dual Fuel Utilization.

3.0 NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENT

Customer is responsible for notifying the Company of any dual fuel equipment at Customer's location upon initial application for service under an applicable rate schedule. Any Customer that installs or has previously installed dual fuel equipment at any time while taking service from the Company under an applicable rate schedule shall notify the Company of the installation.

4.0 TERM

The minimum term shall be one year from the initial operation of dual fuel equipment by the Customer.
