On April 11, 2011, American Utility Management, Inc. (AUM) filed with the Commission an application for initial registration as a natural gas aggregator.

The Commission has reviewed the application for registration as a natural gas aggregator and has determined that it meets the requirements for initial registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.04. Therefore, the Commission will approve AUM as a natural gas aggregator in the State of New Hampshire, with the registration to be effective, May 9, 2011. This initial registration will expire at the end of business on May 8, 2013.

Additionally, please bear in mind that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.05 (a), each aggregator applicant shall re-register with the Commission by filing an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its registration, i.e., in the case of AUM, on or before March 7, 2013.
