Re: DM 11-103, Notification of Freedom Logistics, LLC's Intent to Provide Electric Aggregation Service

Dear Mr. Fromuth:

This is to confirm that the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has received Freedom Logistics, LLC (Freedom)'s notice of intent to provide electric aggregation service in the State of New Hampshire, pursuant to New Hampshire Administrative Rules Puc 2003.05. On May 24, 2011 Freedom filed an amended application and requested waiver of the 60 day pre-expiration renewal notice required by Puc 2003.05(a). Pursuant to Puc 2003.05(a), Freedom's renewal application was due 60 days prior to the expiration date. Freedom explained that the delay was due to an internal administrative error. Freedom also stated that it had not conducted any commercial electricity aggregation since February 18, 2011. Considering the general confusion among aggregators regarding the adoption of a revised Puc 2000 on August 25, 2010, and the fact that Freedom was not engaged in any commercial electricity aggregation activities during the lapse period, Staff recommended to grant the waiver and consider the application as an renewal. Staff has reviewed the application provided and believes that it meets the requirements of Puc 2003.05.


The Commission may waive a rule pursuant to Puc 201.05 if it finds the waiver serves the public interest and the waiver does not disrupt the orderly and efficient resolution of matters before the Commission. The Commission has determined that the applicable standards for a waiver are satisfied and that granting a waiver is consistent with the public good. Therefore, the Commission will approve renewal of Freedom's registration as a provider of electric aggregation service in New Hampshire.

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Please note the following provision of Puc 2003.05 (f): “[E]ach approved aggregator shall re-notify the commission after the initial 2 year period, or after the 5 year renewal period as applicable, by filing with the commission an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the currently effective registration.” Freedom’s original notice anniversary date is February 18, 2009 and therefore it is required to refile an up-to-date written notice on or before **December 18, 2015** if it continues to offer and provide electric aggregation service. In addition, Freedom is subject to the provisions of Puc 2004.03, telephone solicitation of customers, and Puc 2004.08, customer protections provided by aggregators.
