Following the pre-hearing conference on June 24, 2011, representatives of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. (UES), The RiverWoods Company of Exeter, New Hampshire (RiverWoods), the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) and Staff (collectively, the parties) met in a technical session.

Regarding UES's motion for confidential treatment, RiverWoods agreed that its name and identification as a customer of UES need not be deemed to be confidential information. After discussion, RiverWoods expressed support for the motion as to the useage and financial data which are the subject of the motion for confidential treatment and neither the OCA nor Staff expressed an objection to the motion.

In addition, RiverWoods agreed to file a motion to dismiss and/or stay the proceeding on or before July 11, 2011, and it was agreed that the other parties will have the time period set forth in the Commission's procedural rules for filing any objections. Finally, it was agreed that discovery on UES can commence immediately, without the need for a formal procedural schedule at this time.
