To the Parties:

On July 18, 2013, the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) filed a motion to continue the procedural schedule established in Order No. 25,546 (July 15, 2013). In particular, OCA moved to continue the deadline for filing Staff and intervenor testimony from August 23, 2013, to sometime on or after September 20, 2013. The OCA also moved the Commission to alter the procedural schedule to provide for the filing of post-hearing briefs. TransCanada, Conservation Law Foundation, and Sierra Club supported the motion, and no party objected to the motion. The Commission has decided to grant the OCA's motion.

On July 25, 2013, Commission Staff reported that during the technical session held on July 24, 2013, the parties reached agreement on a schedule for the remainder of the proceeding in the event that the Commission granted OCA's motion. The parties also agreed to one round of discovery requests to PSNH upon the completion of Staff's updated audit of scrubber costs. Lastly, the parties agreed to defer to the Commission's decision at the end of the merits hearing as to whether legal briefs will be required.
