On June 21, 2013 the Commission received a letter from TJM Enterprises, Inc. (TJM), requesting the transfer of its REC eligibility for the Flying Goose Brew Pub & Grille photovoltaic array, from TJM single certification code, NH II-11-041 to the Solar Farm Bank aggregation, NH-II-13-010 pursuant to Puc 2505.12. The Commission originally certified TJM's Flying Goose Brew Pub & Grille photovoltaic array as a Class II renewable energy source effective December 06, 2011. The nameplate capacity of the system is 41.4 kilowatts (kW); the facility's current New England Power Pool (NEPOOL) Generation Information System facility code is NON 33773.

The Solar Farm Bank was approved as an aggregator of New Hampshire customersited sources February 05, 2013¹, pursuant to Puc 2506. The New England Power Pool Generation Information System (NEPOOL – GIS) has approved the Solar Farm Bank aggregation as NON 35889.

Since the facility is a customer-sited source, its output is not recorded in the NEPOOL Market Settlement System and, as a result, its output must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. Paul Button will continue to monitor the facility's output as required by the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08(b)(5).
