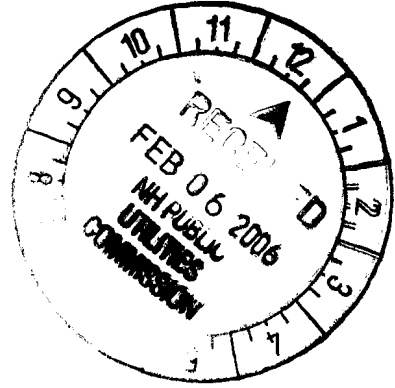



MOTION TO INTERVENE


NOW COMES Brian Lamy and request the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission allow Brian Lamy to intervene in the above referenced docket in for the following reasons:

1. Brian Lamy had previously participated in a PUC docket relating to quality of electrical service in Bedford, New Hampshire.
2. As a result of Bedford Resident's concerns, a number of complaints and concerns were communicated to PSNH, PUC, and OCA relating to the PSNH's delivery of electrical service.
3. Similar to the PUC Order, Brian Lamy and other customers have questioned PSNH's maintenance obligation, safety concerns and tree trimming.
4. Unknown to Bedford Residents, the Bedford Electrical Committee and other residential ratepayers, the PUC issued an Order of Notice on October 24, 2005.
5. The PUC and OCA could have communicated this investigation to parties identified in 03-113 and/or Bedford representatives.

WHEREFORE, I request that the Commission:

- A. Allow Brian Lamy intervenor status; and
- B. Include Brian Lamy on the service list relating to 05-172.
