Eight independent New Hampshire incumbent local exchange carriers who are members of the New Hampshire Telephone Association (the "Eight Independents"), by and through the undersigned counsel and pursuant to RSA 541-A:32 and N.H. Admin. Rule Puc 203.17, hereby petition the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission ("NHPUC") to grant intervention to the Eight Independents in the present proceeding.

In support of their Motion, the Eight Independents state as follows:

1. On January 31, 2007, FairPoint Communications, Inc. ("FairPoint") and Verizon New England, Inc. and certain of its affiliates (collectively, "Verizon" and, with FairPoint, the "Joint Petitioners") jointly petitioned the NHPUC for approval of a transaction (the "Transaction") by which Verizon would transfer its assets and obligations as a telecommunications common carrier in New Hampshire to FairPoint, and Verizon's authority

to offer telecommunications services, both on a wholesale and retail basis in New

Hampshire, would be terminated.

2. The Eight Independents are New Hampshire public utilities under RSA 362:2,I

and operate as incumbent local exchange carriers, as defined in Puc 402.23, subject to the

jurisdiction of the NHPUC under RSA 374:3.

3. The Eight Independents have longstanding traffic arrangements with Verizon,

ensuring the efficient and seamless routing, rating and completion of telecommunications

traffic between and among customers in New Hampshire and between customers in New

Hampshire and around the world.

4. If the proposed Transaction were approved, Verizon's obligations with respect to

the aforesaid arrangements would be terminated and any and all such obligations would

thereupon be assumed by FairPoint.

5. The Eight Independents have rights, duties, privileges, immunities or other

substantial interests in the aforesaid arrangements that may be affected by the present

proceeding.

6. The interests of justice and the orderly and prompt conduct of the present

proceeding will not be impaired by allowing the intervention of the Eight Independents.

7. Based on the foregoing, the Eight Independents assert that they satisfy the

requirements for intervention under RSA 541-A:32.

WHEREFOR, the Eight Independents petition the NHPUC to grant the aforesaid petition for intervention.
