REPLY: Splice Service Technicians (SSTs) are not exclusively dedicated to wholesale maintenance or provisioning work. Any technician in a geographic area can be dispatched on wholesale (or retail) POTS installation or repair work. Special services work typically is dispatched to an SST specifically trained and equipped to install or repair wholesale (or retail) special services.

> In 2005 Verizon averaged 237 SSTs performing all installation and maintenance work in New Hampshire. Of these, the equivalent of approximately 43 techs performed wholesale work. In 2006, Verizon averaged 262 SSTs performing all installation and maintenance work in New Hampshire. Of these, the equivalent of approximately 47 techs performed wholesale work. In the first two months of 2007, Verizon averaged 231 SSTs in New Hampshire, with an equivalent workforce of 42 techs performing the wholesale work. The above equivalent workforce numbers were derived from the percentage of the total dispatches for installation and maintenance versus the number of dispatches associated with wholesale work.
