Registration as a Natural Gas Aggregator

Dear Mr. Sakellaris:

On December 6, 2010, Ameresco, Inc. (Ameresco) filed with the Commission an application for registration as a natural gas aggregator, together with a check for the initial application fee of \$250.00.

The Commission has reviewed the application for registration as a natural gas aggregator and has determined that it meets the requirements for registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.04 (Adopted Rule 9/24/10). Therefore, the Commission will approve Ameresco as a natural gas aggregator in the State of New Hampshire, with the registration to be effective December 22, 2010. This initial registration will expire at the end of business on December 21, 2012.

Additionally, please bear in mind that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.05 (a), each aggregator applicant shall re-register with the Commission by filing an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its registration, i.e., in the case of Ameresco, on or before October 21, 2012. Instructions on how to properly file a renewal registration application are located on the Commission website at http://www.puc.nh.gov/Gas-Steam/CNGS-aggregator%20application%20instructions.pdf. We urge Ameresco to use the Commission's requested filing format, including cover letter, for its renewal application in October 2012.
