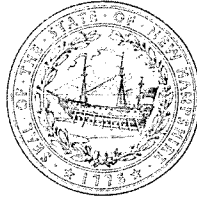

Certification Applications for Class II Eligibility Pursuant to RSA 362-F:

Dear Mr. McNeil:

On January 28, 2013, you submitted applications on behalf of New Hampshire residents Kempe, Warren, and Smith requesting that the Commission grant approval of photovoltaic facilities located at each of these residences to produce Class II, Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard law. The application for Fiske was received January 30, 2013. Staff has reviewed these applications and has recommended approval of the above-named applicants' photovoltaic arrays as eligible for Class II RECs effective January 28, 2013 for Kempe, Warren and Smith, and January 30, 2013 for Fiske.


Since these facilities are customer-sited sources, the output is not recorded in the New England Power Pool Market Settlement System and, as a result the output must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. Your application states that NHEC will monitor the facilities' output as required by N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08 and 2505.09. These facilities' total output will also be included in the *NHEC Class II Aggregation's* total output reported to the NEPOOL Generation Information System as approved by the Commission on April 9, 2010.

The details for these facilities are listed in the following table.
