Dear Ms. Howland:

In accordance with the Commission's Order No. 25,500, enclosed is an original copy of the monthly calculation of the projected (over)/under collection for the 2013 summer period.

The computations are based on actual costs and revenues through August and forecasts for the remainder of the period. The calculations show a projected over-collection through October 31, 2013 of \$6,230 and would necessitate a \$0.1290 decrease to the current Cost of Gas Rate of \$1.6654, resulting in a revised COG Rate of \$1.5364 per therm. At this time, the Company elects to implement the revised rate of \$1.5364 per therm for the October 1st billing cycle.

Included in this package is an original copy of New Hampshire Gas Corporation's tariff page in compliance with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission's Order No. 25,500 – Order Approving Cost of Gas Rate, issued April 26, 2013.
