

Dear Ms. Howland:



The adjusted cost of gas rates are being filed to reflect an update of the summer period deferred gas cost balance and the projected commodity prices for the remainder of the summer period, including optimizing the dispatch of supply volumes based on revised pricing. The attached estimated cost of gas was calculated using the 15-day average NYMEX settled prices as of May 17, 2013. The adjustments to the cost of gas rates are summarized in the following table.

The enclosed calculation page indicates that absent the adjustment, there would be an estimated under collection of gas costs as of October 31, 2013 of approximately \$541,696 or 4.21%.
