**RE: DG 13-085 EnergyNorth Natural Gas, Inc.
2013 Summer Period Cost of Gas – September 2013 Trigger**

Dear Ms. Howland:

On behalf of EnergyNorth Natural Gas, Inc. d/b/a Liberty Utilities (the "Company") and in accordance with New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission Order No. 25,501, dated April 29, 2013 in Docket DG 13-085, I enclose an original and two copies of the Company's current calculation of its projected over or under collection of gas costs for the 2013 summer season ending October 31, 2013.

For May through August 2013, the calculation reflects the actual NYMEX settled prices. For September and October 2013, the calculation reflects the 15-day average NYMEX closing prices as of August 19, 2013. The resulting projected over collection of \$242,282 is approximately 2.0% of the total anticipated gas costs for the 2013 summer season. Accordingly, the Company does **not** elect a rate change effective September 1, 2013, and therefore, has not attached any revised tariff pages.


The cost of gas rates are summarized in the following table.
