Renewal of Natural Gas Aggregator Registration

Dear Mr. Lesser:

On May 10, 2013, EnergyRebate Inc. (EnergyRebate) filed with the Commission an application for renewal of its registration as a natural gas aggregator, together with the renewal application of \$125.00.


Commission Staff notes that EnergyRebate's original registration as an aggregator expires on June 24, 2013; only 44 days after EnergyRebate filed its renewal application with the Commission. Despite this oversight, Commission Staff has determined that the renewal application for registration as a natural gas aggregator meets the requirements for registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.05. On May 28, 2013, Staff filed its recommendation to approve the application with the expectation that EnergyRebate will remain cognizant of Commission requirements for registration renewal going forward. The Commission will approve the registration with an effective date of June 25, 2013, which coincides with the expiration of the existing registration for EnergyRebate. The renewal registration will expire at the end of business on June 24, 2018.

Please be aware that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3005.02(a), each aggregator shall re-register with the Commission by filing an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its registration, i.e., in the case of EnergyRebate, on or before April 25, 2018. Please file a timely renewal application.

Registration instructions and a checklist of requirements to properly file a renewal registration application can be accessed from the Natural Gas Competition page of the Commission website (<http://puc.nh.gov/Gas-Steam/naturalgascompetition.htm>).

All registered natural gas aggregators in the State of New Hampshire are subject to specific requirements contained in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3000 – Competitive Natural Gas Supplier and Aggregator Rules. These rules can be found on our website at: <http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Rules/PUC3000.pdf>.
