This is a follow-up to the voicemail I just left you. Today, the Commission received a copy of your filing containing Neighborhood Energy Consultant's certificate of formation. This, however, does not address the issue in the deficiency letter I sent you on 9/20/2013. In order to register as an aggregator of electric service, you must submit a certificate from the Secretary of State's Office stating that you are authorized to do business in NH. The certificate has a raised seal, and, oftentimes, applicants have to make a special request to the SOS office to receive it. As it stands now, your application is still deficient.
