## Dear Ms. Howland:

The Commission issued an order of notice in the above captioned matter and scheduled a prehearing conference for October 28, 2013. Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH), the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) and Staff attended the prehearing conference. Conservation Law Foundation (CLF) and North American Power and Gas (NAPG) filed Petitions to Intervene and also attended the prehearing conference. PSNH objected to both petitions and the Commission heard argument on the matter at the prehearing conference; however, the Commission did not make a decision on the Petitions to Intervene at the prehearing conference and did not issue a statement on the scope of the proceeding.

At the technical session that followed the prehearing conference, PSNH, the OCA, Staff, CLF and NAPG agreed to the following procedural schedule:

Although their intervenor status was not decided, CLF and NAPG agreed to the proposed schedule.

Staff on behalf of the parties respectfully requests that the Commission approve the proposed procedural schedule. We note that we propose the same schedule for the PSNH petition to establish a 2014 stranded cost recovery charge (DE 13-274), with the merits hearing in the DE 13-274 to be held at 10:00 on December 16, 2013, prior to the proposed hearing in the instant docket. The petitions in the instant docket and in DE 13-274 request approval of rates for effect January 1, 2014.
