Application to Renew Registration as Provider of Electric Aggregation Service

Dear Ms. O'Connell:

On November 13, 2013, RJT Energy Consultants, LLC (RJT Energy) submitted an application with the Commission to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service. Staff reviewed the application and determined that it is complete. Staff noted that the application was not filed within 60 days of the currently expiring registration as required by N.H. Admin Code Puc 2003.05(a). Despite RJT Energy's late filing, Staff recommended that the Commission approve the application because RJT Energy acknowledged it did not timely submit its renewal and because this is the first time RJT Energy has been tardy with its filing.

The Commission accepts Staff's recommendation and approves your application to renew your registration as a provider of electric aggregation service, effective December 5, 2013. The registration is for a term of 5 years and expires at the end of business on December 4, 2018. Pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rule Puc 2003.05(a), you must submit your next renewal application at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the registration approved here, on or before October 5, 2018.

Please be aware that registered providers of electric aggregation service are subject to specific requirements contained in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2000 – Competitive Electric Power Supplier and Aggregator Rules. These rules are available at <a href="http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Rules/PUC2000.pdf">http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Rules/PUC2000.pdf</a>. Please also be aware that the Commission has opened Docket DRM 13-151 to consider revisions to these rules.
