Dear Mr. Morrissey:

On July 14, 2014, Best Practice Energy, LLC (Best Practice) submitted an application with the Commission to register as a provider of electric aggregation service. Staff reviewed the application and determined that it is complete.

The Commission approves your application effective July 30, 2014. The registration is for a term of 2 years and expires at the end of business on July 29, 2016. Pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rule Puc 2003.05(a), you must submit your next renewal application at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the registration approved here, on or before May 31, 2016.

Please be aware that registered providers of electric aggregation service are subject to specific requirements contained in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2000 – Competitive Electric Power Supplier and Aggregator Rules. These rules are available at: <http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Rules/PUC2000.pdf>. Please also be aware that the Commission has opened Docket DRM 13-151 to consider revisions to these rules. All non-confidential filings in Docket DRM 13-151 can be found at <http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Docketbk/2013/13-151.html>. The revised rules may contain different requirements for maintaining registration as a provider of electric aggregation service that might affect your registration. Pursuant to Senate Bill 324, effective July 1, 2014, providers of electric load aggregation are subject to an annual assessment of \$2,000.
