## RE: DG 14-220 Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities 2014/2015 Winter Period Cost of Gas – December 2014 Trigger

Dear Ms. Howland:

On behalf of Liberty Utilities (the "Company) and in accordance with New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission") Order No. 25,730 dated October 31, 2014, in Docket DG 14-220, I enclose for filing the Company's current calculation of its projected over or under collection of gas costs for the 2014/2015 winter season ending April 30, 2015.

The calculation reflects the actual November2014 NYMEX settled prices. For December 2014, the calculation reflects the NYMEX closing prices as of November 20, 2014. The resulting projected over collection of approximately \$384,718 is approximately 0.53% of the total revised anticipated gas costs for the 2014/2015 winter season.

The current and revised cost of gas rates are summarized in the following table.
