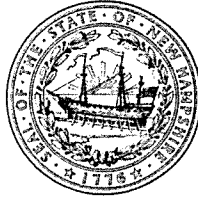

Dear Attorney Cunningham:

On May 11, 2015, you filed on behalf of the Town of Fitzwilliam a letter notifying the Commission that it wished to intervene in docket IR 15-124, investigating potential approaches to ameliorate adverse wholesale electricity market conditions in New Hampshire. You indicated that the Town of Fitzwilliam requested intervention to insure that any findings or orders made by the Public Utilities Commission in this investigative docket do not impair the rights of the Town of Fitzwilliam in any state of federal adjudicative bodies, including but not limited to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, the Public Utilities Commission and the Site Evaluation Committee and the state and federal courts."

The present docket is an investigation pursuant to RSA 365:5 and RSA 374:4 and will be conducted by Commission Staff in order to inform the Commission as to matters concerning the wholesale electricity market. The Commission welcomes the participation of the Town of Fitzwilliam but because this is an investigation and not an adjudication, there is no need for interventions. As noted in the order of notice commencing this docket, the Commission instructed Staff to reach out to all stakeholders, which would include the Town of Fitzwilliam, as part of its investigation. At the conclusion of this investigation the Commission will issue a written summary of the investigation and the Commission's findings for dissemination to the public.
