RE: Request by Freedom Ring Communications LLC, /d/b/a BayRing Communications for license to construct and maintain fiber optic telecommunications cable crossing Brown's River (aka Tide Mill Creek) in the town of Hampton NH.

Dear Ms. Howland,

Pursuant to RSA 371:17-a, as enacted by Senate Bill 175, BayRing Communications hereby notifies the Commission of its intent to place fiber optic cable and associated wires and fixtures over the Brown's River in Hampton NH.

The map coordinates of the crossing are: Attachment to Unutil Pole #502 at GPS coordinates Lat:42.922537, Long:-70.823455, and Unutil Pole #503 at GPS coordinates Lat:42.921827, Long:-70.822893.

This is an existing pole line built in 2015, with existing power lines attached to the fore mentioned poles, crossing the Brown's River in the town of Hampton NH.

Pertinent sections of the pole attachment application are enclosed with this request. The pole application is being processed by Unutil Energy Systems Inc. Also enclosed are the Unutil plans for the existing pole line with the crossing highlighted and a Google Maps map of the crossing location.

Further, as required under RSA 371:17-a, the enclosed affidavit, signed by the responsible director within BayRing Communications, confirms the crossing shall be completed in compliance with the National Electrical Safety Code and with the required pole attachment licenses that will be obtained from the pole owners.
