

Enclosed please find, pursuant to Puc 203.02 (a) (1), an original and six copies of a petition to increase the short term debt limit for PEU and PAC (the Companies) pursuant to RSA 369:7. The Companies also seek a waiver, pursuant to Puc 201.05, of Puc 608.05, which limits short term debt to 10% of net fixed plant.
