Report of Technical Session

Dear Ms. Howland:

On August 14, 2015, Vivint Solar, Inc. (Vivint) filed a Petition for Declaratory Ruling Regarding RSA 362:2, 362-A:2-a and Rule Puc 2002.05. The Petition seeks a ruling from the Commission declaring that, in offering solar power purchase agreements or solar leases to residential customers in New Hampshire, neither Vivint, nor its subsidiary or affiliates, will be regulated by the Commission as (1) a "public utility" under RSA 362:2, (2) a "competitive electric power supplier" under N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2002.05, or (3) a "limited producer of electrical energy" under RSA 362-A:2-a.

The Commission issued an Order of Notice on September 3, 2015 scheduling a pre-hearing conference for October 8, 2015 and setting a deadline for petitions to intervene of October 6, 2015. Petitions for intervention were timely filed by The Alliance for Solar Choice (TASC) and by Freedom Logistics, LLC d/b/a Freedom Energy Logistics (FEL). There were no objections to the petitions for intervention, and the Commission granted the two interventions during the pre-hearing conference held on October 8, 2015.

Following the pre-hearing conference, representatives of Vivint, TASC, FEL, and Staff met in technical session to discuss issues regarding the scope of and procedure for the proceeding, including the conduct of discovery and the potential to develop factual stipulations for filing with the Commission.

The technical session participants agreed to recommend the following procedural schedule to the Commission:

Vivint Responses to Data Requests Oct. 26, 2015

Technical Session Nov. 3, 2015 at 10:00 a.m.

Legal Brief of Petitioner Due Nov. 6, 2015

Reply Briefs of Staff and Interveners Nov. 20, 2015

Hearing on Merits Dec. 3, 2015 at 1:00 p.m.
