



Termination of Registration of as a Provider of Electric Aggregation
Service

On September 16, 2016, EnerNOC, Inc. (EnerNOC), a registered provider of electric aggregation service, filed a notice with the Commission that it had merged with World Energy Solutions, Inc. (World Energy), also a registered provider of electric aggregation service, effective as of August 15, 2016, in a merger in which EnerNOC is the surviving entity. EnerNOC requested the withdrawal of World Energy's registration as a separate provider of electric load aggregation.

Because World Energy no longer exists as a separate legal entity, Staff believes that the Commission's records should be revised to reflect that change in circumstances. The separate registration of World Energy as an electric aggregator should be terminated and Docket DM 15-371 closed, and World Energy should be removed from the Commission's website listing of registered electric aggregators.
